What makes our program unique?

Important information: After January 1, 2018, coursework for the CDA certificate, technical diploma and certificate of technical studies must be earned from a BESE-approved provider in order for an individual to be eligible for the Early Childhood Ancillary Certificate.

Beginning July 2019, all lead teachers working in publicly funded early learning centers must hold, at a minimum, an early childhood ancillary certificate.
